MASTER BOARD NEWS

The Master Board held its monthly meeting on February 19, 2026 At 6:00 in the clubhouse.

Updates on projects: The gym floor has been completed. We have the addition of treadmills, and a tv for the room. We are still considering what else needs to be added. We will update you when we have finished. We are in the process of refreshing our entrance walls and planters. We are replacing the old "Snug Harbor Lakes " signage, which has been in dire need of updating . We are replacing the expired flowers etc.. and cleaning up the flower beds in front of the entrance walls and adding some fresh greenery.

Just to recap a few projects that we have been working on over the past year: The front office and board room have had a refreshing coat of paint, old carpeting replaced, files have been decluttered, upgraded computer software, removal of deteriorated hedges in front of clubhouse Kyak court, replaced with decorative nautical poles and ropes. Cleaned out the maintenance building. Pool area had the pavers sealed, patio furniture power washed, and straps replaced to extend the life of the furniture. The courtyard near the pool has been cleaned out, and replaced with fresh plants. The Reserve Study Analysis has been scheduled for the beginning of March. We will be giving updates when we get the information. Bill from Helping Hands has volunteered to put up a few speed signs. We welcome all residents to attend our monthly meetings and bring any questions or concerns you may have.

Our next meeting will be held on Thursday March 19, 2026 at 6pm in the clubhouse.

VILLAGE NEWS

Snug Harbor Village did not achieve quorum to hold their Annual Meeting on February 24th, however, a Regular Board Meeting was held and member, Marie Myint was appointed to fill one of the two vacant seats on the Board. Welcome to the team Marie! We do still need one more member of the Village to step forward. The Board wants to thank Debbie Haines for her service as Treasurer over the past year. We will miss you Debbie! The next meeting will be on Mar. 17.

CONDO NEWS

The new board has hit the ground running! We are still looking for volunteers for our 3 newly established committees- a legal counsel search committee, a financial investment advisory committee, and a committee to investigate moving forward with electronic communications. Each will report monthly (or as required) to the Board with their findings. Remember, this is **your** community. As we said last month, we don't feel it is unreasonable to expect that there would be 9 people out of our 390 or so residents who are not already serving on a Board who would be willing to share their time and knowledge to help with these projects. None will require a large investment of your time. To date only 4 of 9 slots are filled. Please feel free to contact the office and they will steer you to the person who can best answer any questions you might have.

In response to your requests, we have also begun the process of identifying ongoing infractions of our by-laws, predominantly starting with safety issues. (ie parking on the streets/swales; pole lights not working or too dim; house numbers missing/unreadable; houses in need of clean-up/powerwashing.) If any of this pertains to you, you may soon be receiving a call from Cindy, our community manager, who we have requested to follow up on these issues. We are trying to maintain our community to the high standards that impressed us

when we moved here. We appreciate your cooperation in resolving these matters. We will be taking regular trips around the community to identify various “violations” of our bylaws and bringing them to the owner’s attention in the hopes of an easy and quick resolution with a phone call. Please treat the office manager with respect if you do receive a phone call. She is acting on our behalf, for the best interest of the entire community. If you have a specific complaint, you can follow the procedure outlined in last month’s newsletter for bringing it to the board’s attention. A draft copy of the minutes from the Feb. meeting are posted at the Clubhouse. Our next meeting at the Clubhouse is scheduled for Mar. 19 at 6:30pm. Hope to see YOU there!

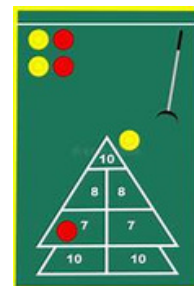

Ireland came to celebrate his day with religious services and feasts.
